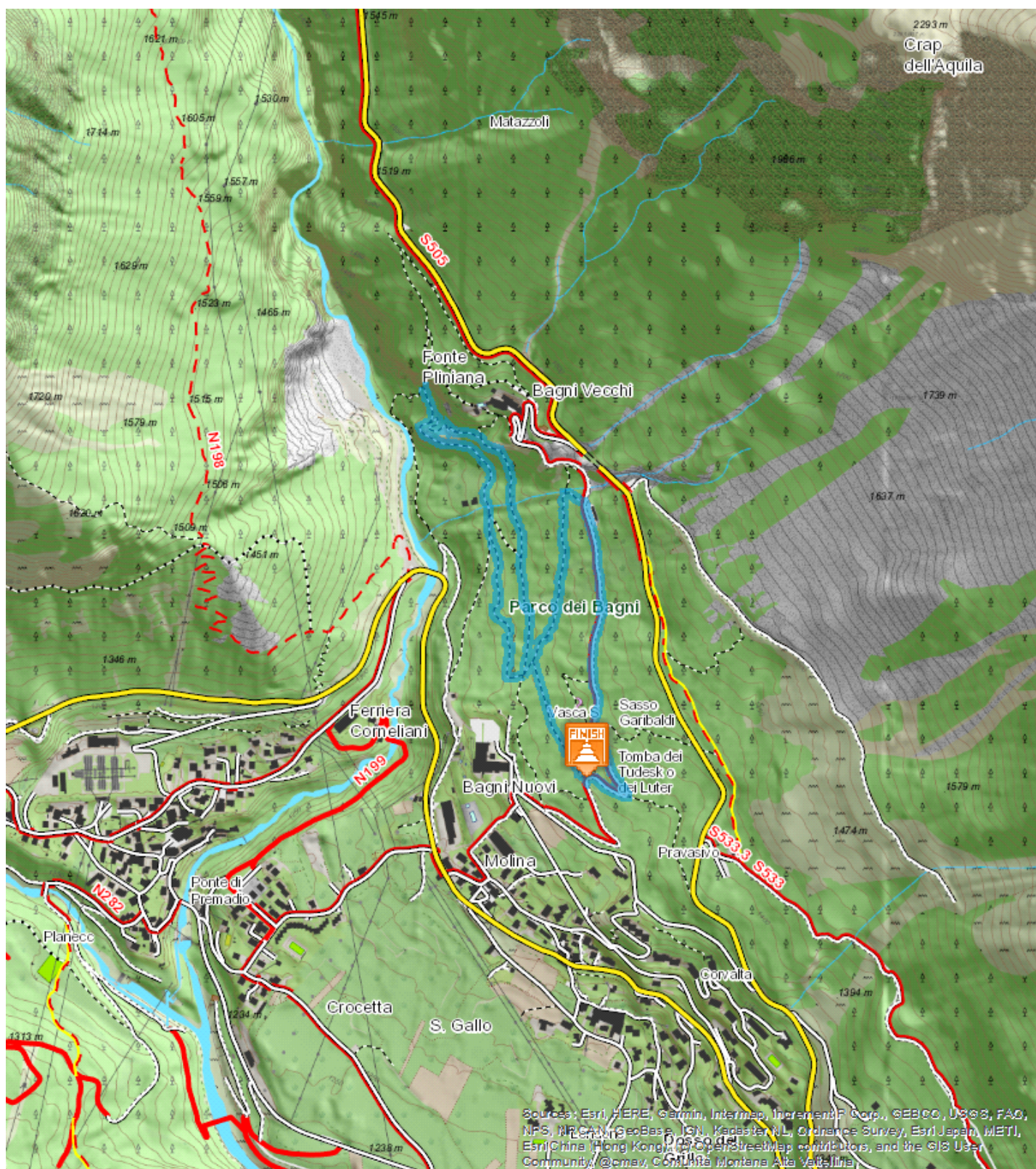

The walk to the Plinian spring develops in the Parco dei Bagni. The path inside the park unwinds along a path up to 8km long and the walk can last from 20min up to a maximum of 1h.



Located in the Stelvio National Park on the southern slope of Mount Reit, the Fonte Pliniana (Plinian Spring) is immersed in a romantic park. The area is freely accessible and is situated between the spa resorts of the Bagni Nuovi and the Bagni Vecchi. The woods that lead to the Fonte Pliniana were planted in the Nineteenth Century to make the area more welcoming for the guests staying at both spa resorts. Today, the rich alpine vegetation of this area is composed of pine, larch, fir, mugo pines, heather, and also hosts several species of Mediterranean flora, which are able to grow thanks to the particularly temperate micro climate which is a product of the hot waters and from the excellent solar exposure.

After a short walk among tall fir and larch trees, you enter the ravine of the Adda valley. At the end of the path you are greeted by a particular artificial cave built around the Fonte Pliniana from which hot water flows.

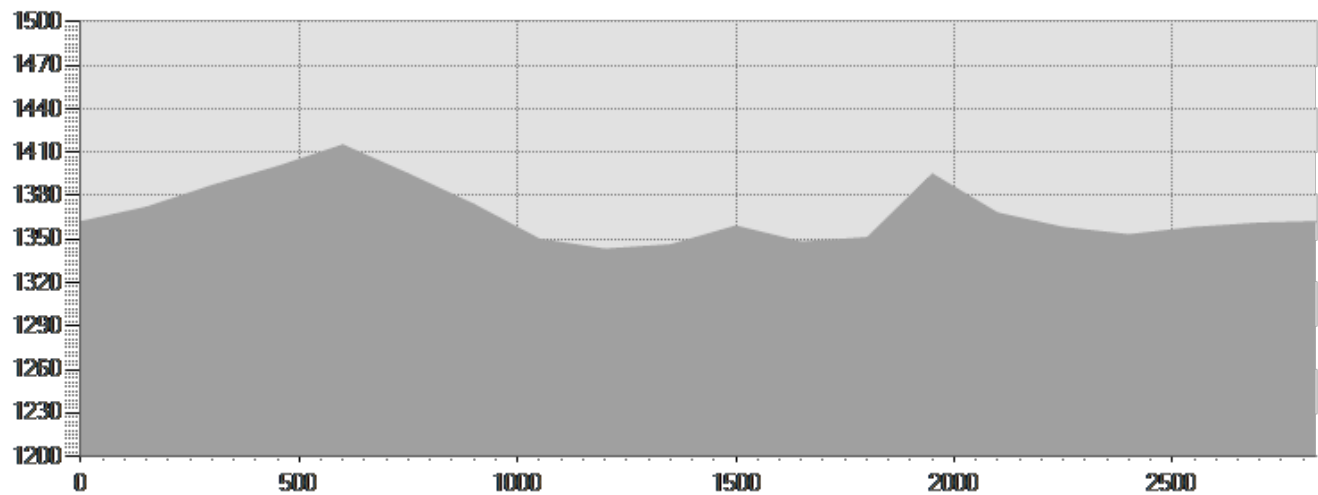

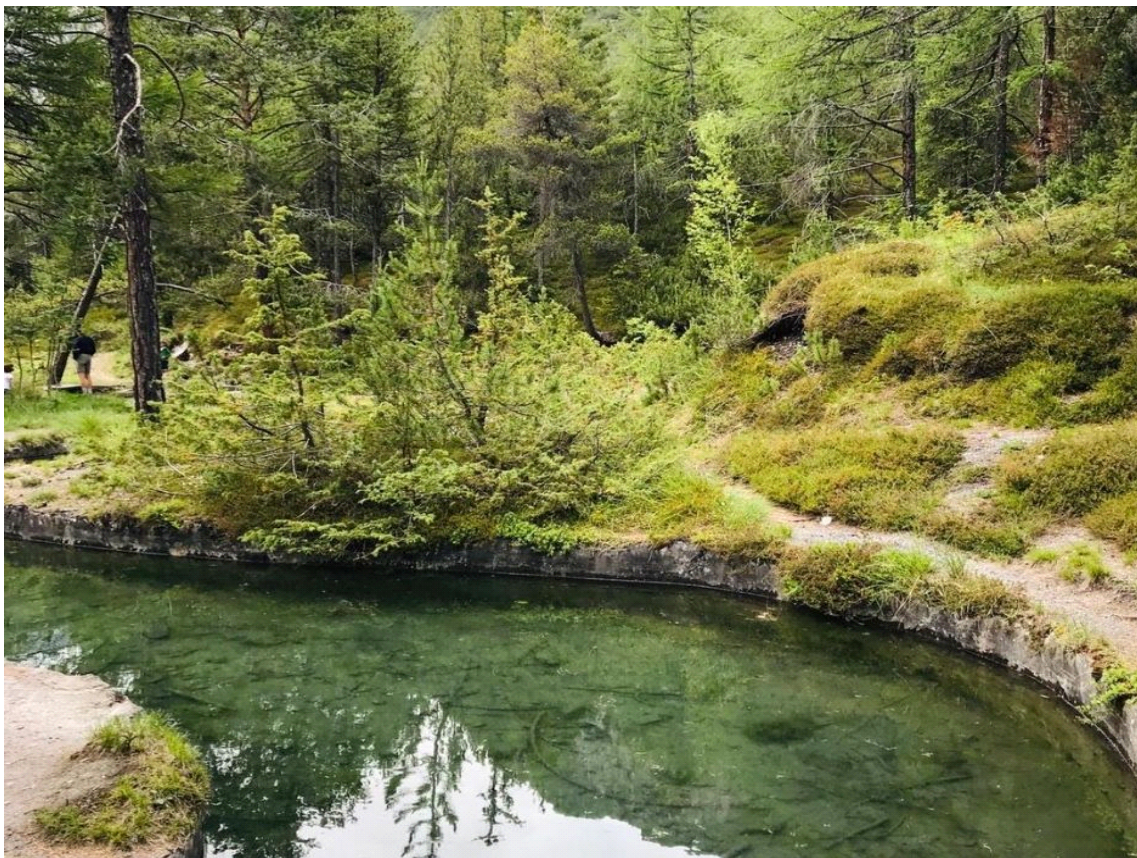
