

In 2004 Damiano Cunego made this climb famous when he won a section of the Giro d'Italia before going on to claim the pink shirt in the end. The climb leads up to 2000 metres, directly along ski slopes, and is notable for its wide turns through the forest. Professionals use the trail on their days off between one big climb and the next. Other cyclists will sweat the entire climb. The view of the MAGNIFICENT LAND is like a postcard.


