



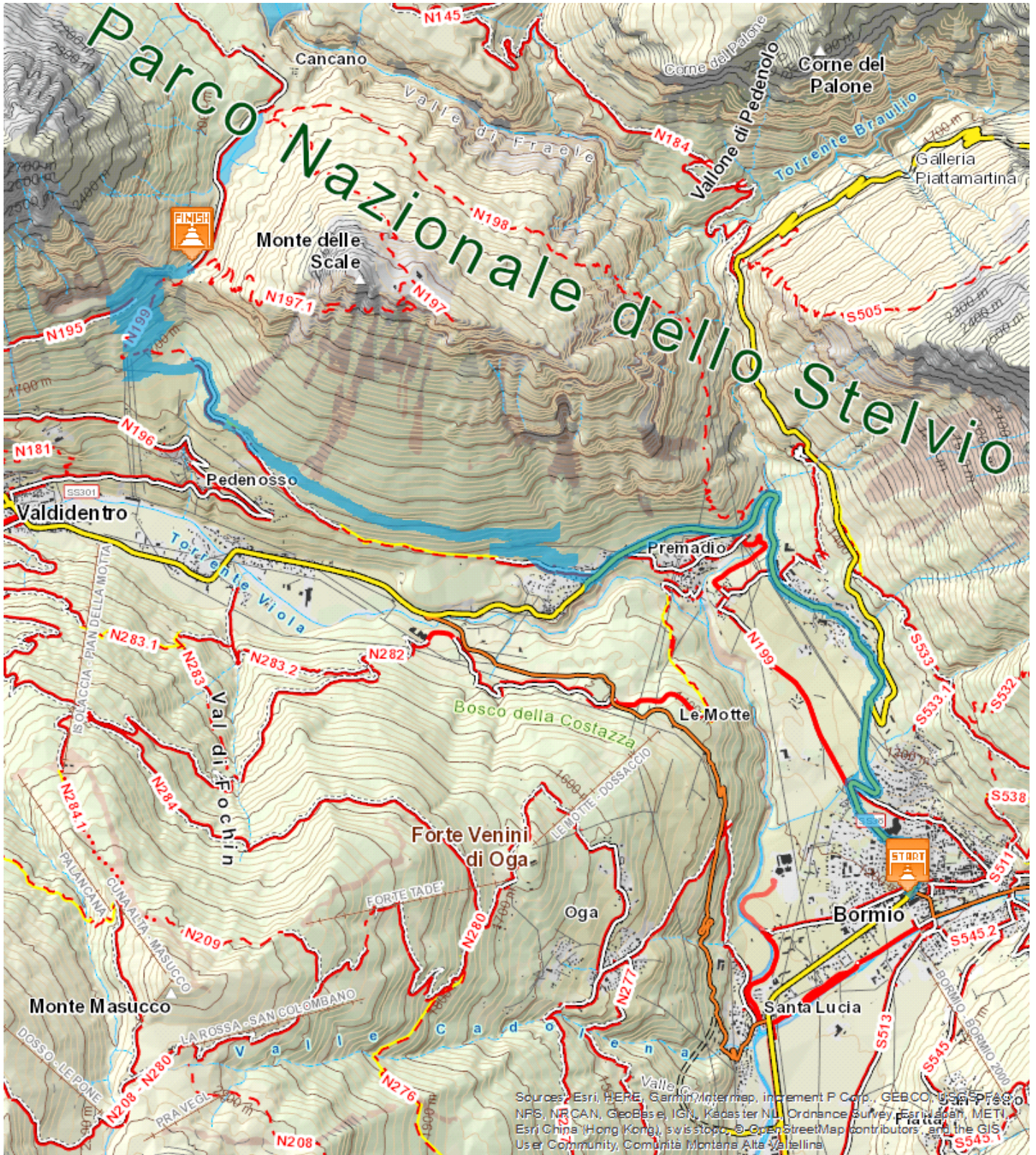


Bormio - Cancano

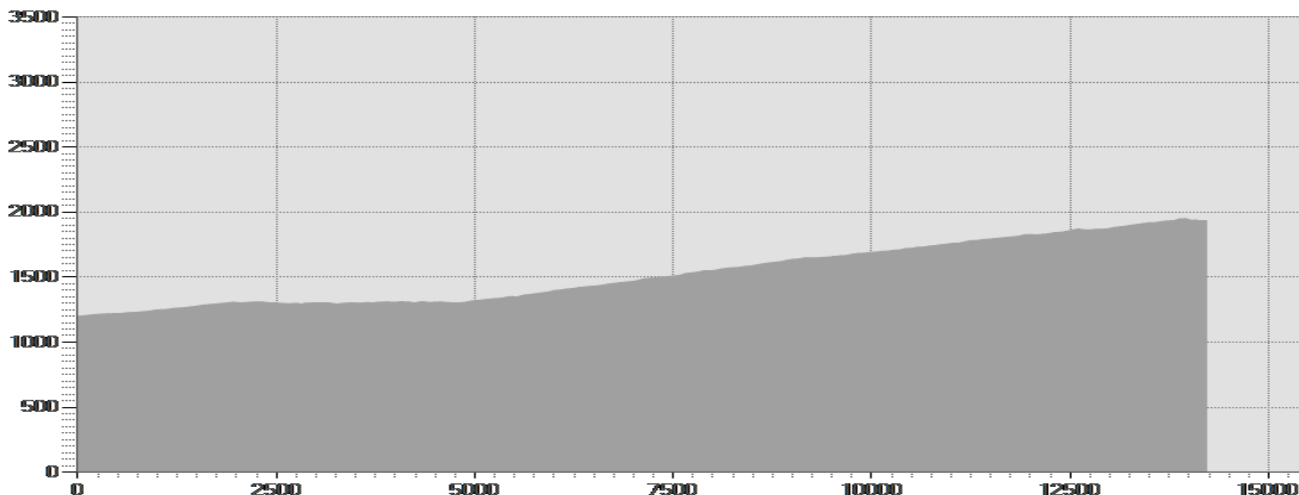
